

# Bienvenue Birdies Craft

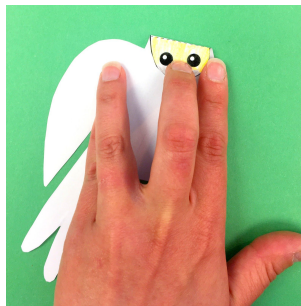

## Materials

- Crayons / Pencil Crayons / Markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- Construction paper

## Directions

1. Print out the Bienvenue Birdies colouring sheet. (See next page)
2. Colour your cute little birdies heads, wings and tails any colours you wish. These are your birds to admire!
3. Cut out the birds.
4. If you wish, at this point you can colour the belly or the bird, or leave blank. The creation is up to you!
5. Fold the head, wing, and tail along the dotted lines.



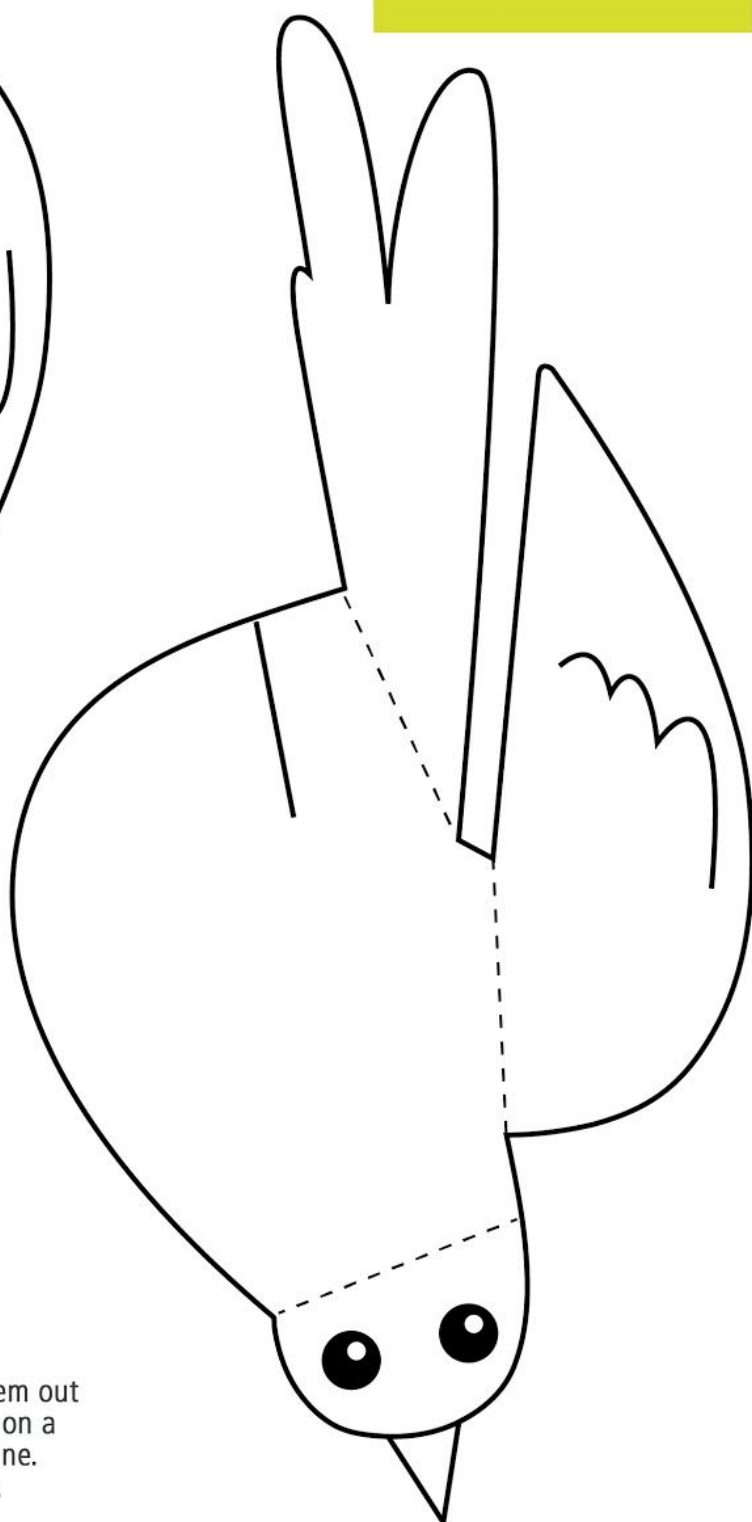
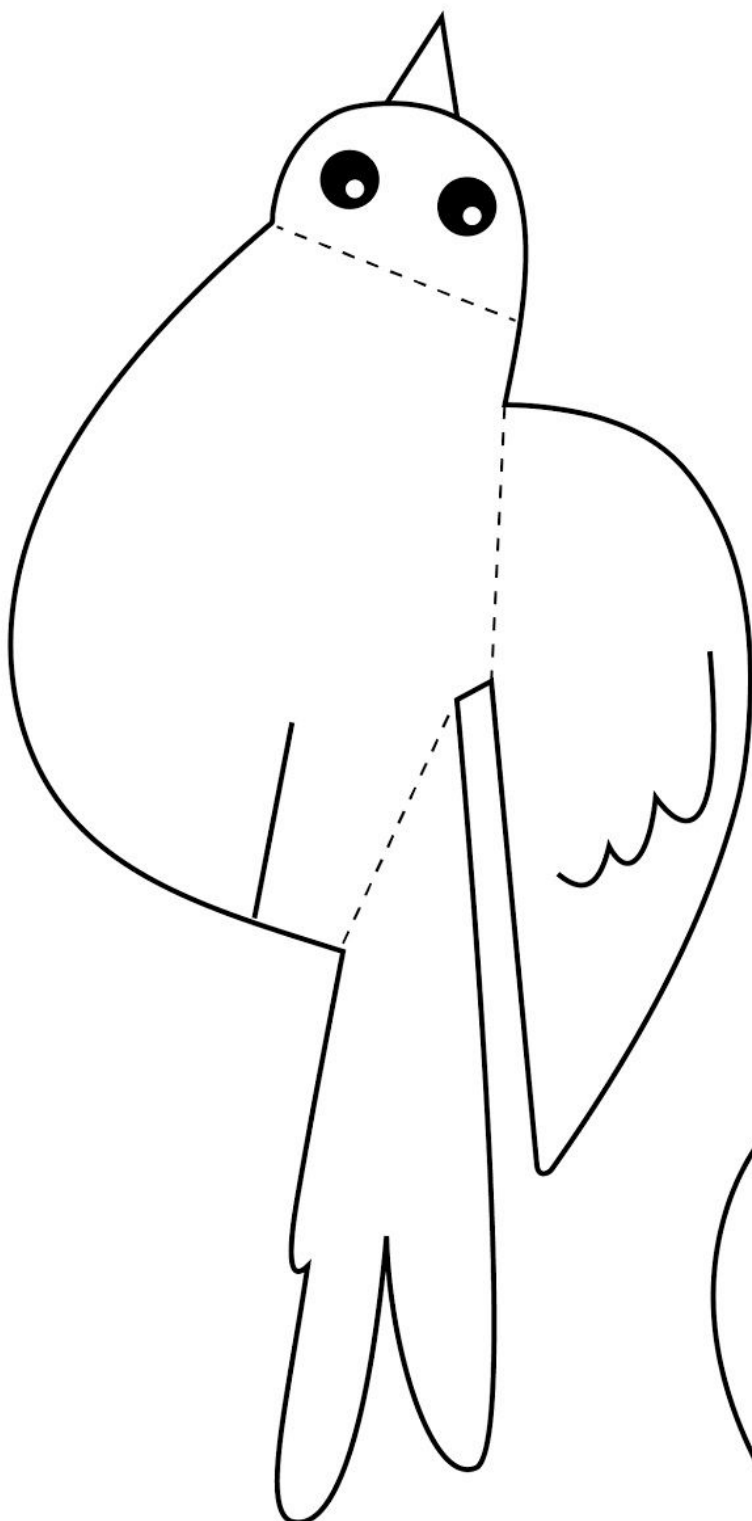
6. Cut the slit cut line on the bottom of the bird belly.



7. Time for the construction paper! Have your main background piece then cut a branch or two for your cute little birdies to perch on.
8. Slit the birds on the branch and position as you want, then glue down.

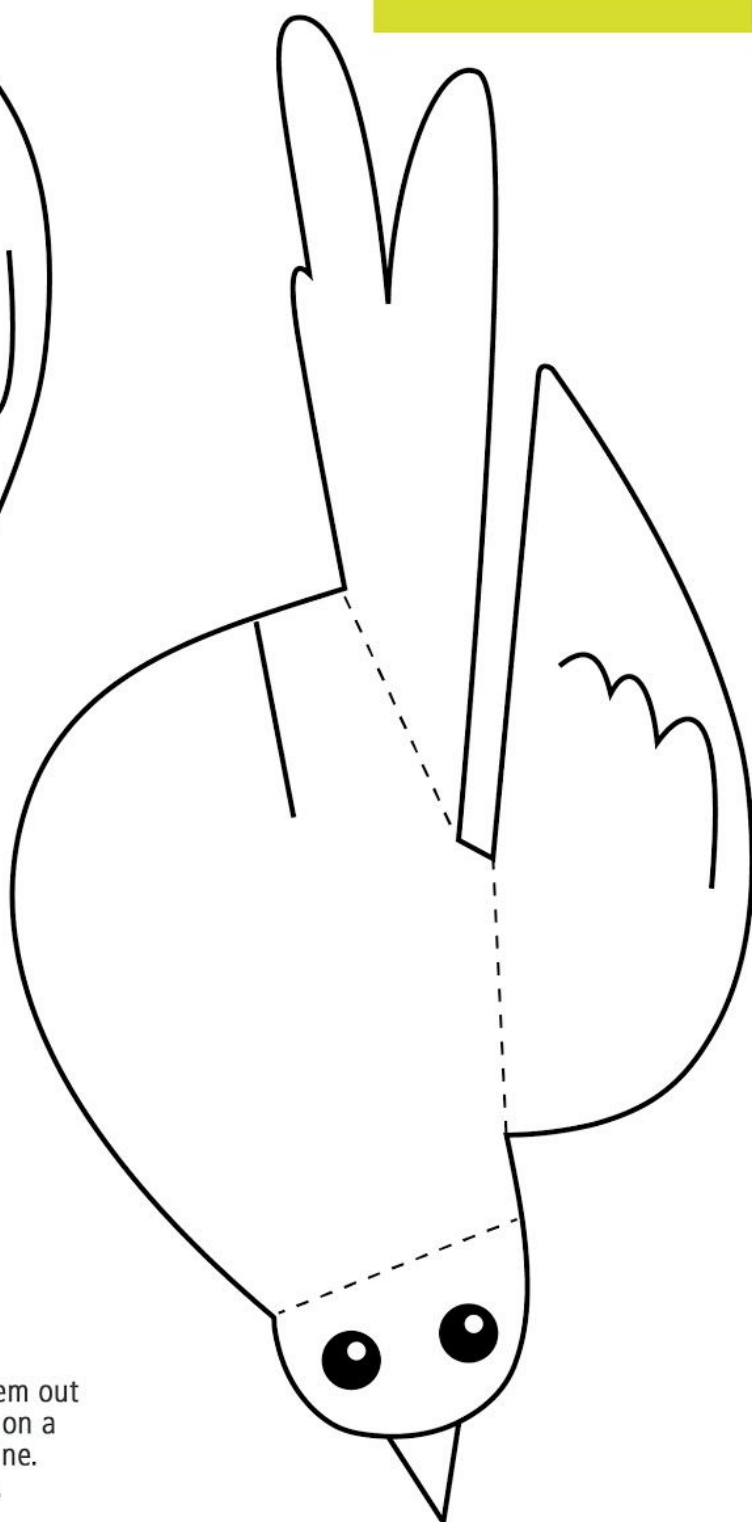
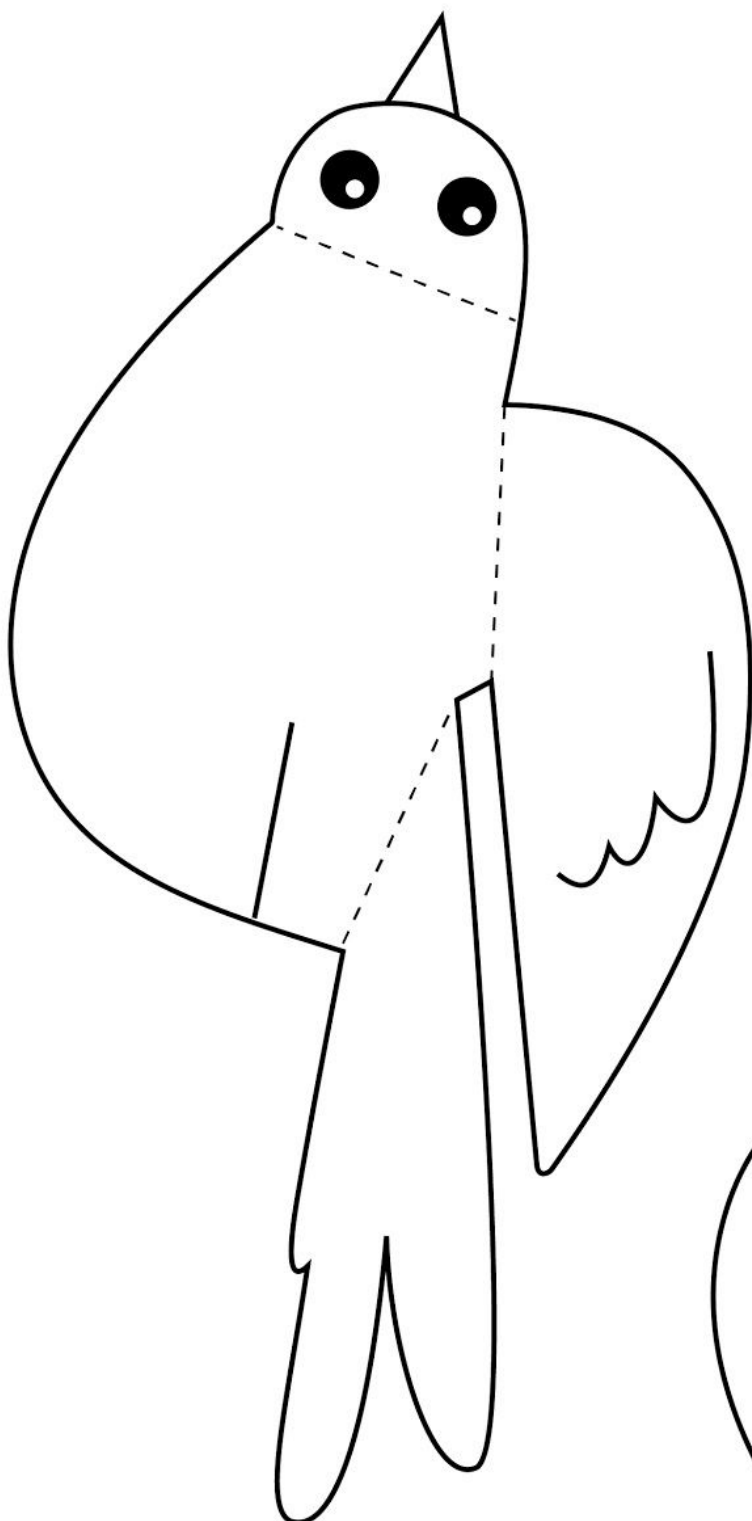
